MEDIA FIRE INCIDENT FORM

DATE OF CALL: February 10, 2021

Miles City Fire & Rescue/Custer County Fire, fight structure fire in subzero temps.

At 15:02 hours Miles City Fire Rescue and Custer County Fire were dispatched for a structure fire at 1013 Alice Street, in Miles City. On scene MCFR found a single family dwelling with heavy smoke exiting the structure. Firefighters made an aggressive interior attack and brought the fire under control in around 30 minutes. Two occupants received minor burns and smoke inhalation. Both occupants were treated on scene by EMT's and then sent to the hospital for further evaluation and treatment.

The structure received heavy fire and smoke damage. Great care was given to ensure that there was no more damage to the property and the occupants were supported and taken care of.

MCFR responded with two engines, one command vehicles, three ambulances, and one rescue truck with an air unit. Custer County Fire responded with one engine, two tenders, and one squad. The teamwork at the fire incident was essential in bringing the incident under control, as MCFR was on two other medical calls at the time of the fire.

The home is estimated to have sustained \$70,000 in damage. The cause of the fire is under investigation.
