Defendant's Name: TIMOTHY SULLIVANAgency Case No. 2411-1081

Statement of Probable Cause continued:

█████ stated Timothy called her adult sons and told them to say goodbye to █████ because he was going to kill her. Upon running out of the residence in fear for their safety, █████ heard a gun shot.

Officers arrived and heard several more gunshots within the home. At one Point Timothy came out of the residence with a hand gun and a long gun, one in each hand. He pointed them in the direction of officers on scene (Officer Brad Barton, Officer Lynn Matthias Lynn, Sgt. Abel Samano, Officer Max Wozniak, Officer Robert Murray, Officer James Reigert, Officer Kyle Hartsuck, and Sgt. Powell) The officers were approximately 30- 40 ft from Timothy when he fired more than 1 round. Officers believed the rounds struck the vehicle parked in the driveway of the residence. All officers were clearly identifiable with police uniform/ insignia. They had fully marked vehicles and were giving verbal commands. Officers heard Timothy say something to the effect of just shoot me. He eventually put the guns down, and was detained after a tazer depolymnet. The officers were in fear of their safety.

A canvas of the neighboring houses was completed. Officers noted that several residence advised they heard the gun shot. Robert Stickale was home when he heard gunshots. Officers located 3 bullet holes in his residence Robert was in his master bedroom when the bullets entered his residence.

PM Timothy admitted to shooting off his gun intentionally in his house, and from his garage. He denied attempting to shoot at officers stating he just shot at his van. Of note the van was in the direction of officers. He admitted he knew the officers were there and weighed his options of fighting but decided to surrender.

He admitted sending █████ son the text stating he was going to kill his mother, but he stated he meant it figuratively.
