MINUTE ENTRY

CHANGE OF PLEA/DONALD HEARING

Defendant present, out of custody.

The Court and counsel confer.

Victim is present.

Defendant sworn.

The Court questions the Defendant regarding his understanding of the terms and conditions of the plea agreement, the possible consequences thereof, and the constitutional rights he waives by entering the plea.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of COUNT TWO: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT RESULTING IN SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY, a Class Three Felony, committed on or about April 1, 2025.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of COUNT FOUR: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT RESULTING IN SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY, a Class Three Felony, committed on or about April 1, 2025.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of COUNT SIX: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT RESULTING IN SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY, a Class Three Felony, committed on or about April 1, 2025.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of COUNT FORTY-NINE: CRIMINAL DAMAGE, GREATER THAN \$10K, DEFACE, a Class Four Felony, committed on or about April 1, 2025.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of COUNT FIFTY: DRIVING OR ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL WHILE IMPAIRED TO THE SLIGHTEST DEGREE, a Class One Misdemeanor, committed on or about April 1, 2025.

The Court questions the Defendant regarding the factual basis for the plea.

The Court incorporates the Grand Jury transcript as further factual basis.

MINUTE ENTRY

THE COURT FINDS that the Defendant knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently enters a plea to the charges set forth in the plea agreement, and that there is a factual basis for the plea.

The plea is accepted and entered of record.

Upon stipulation of counsel,

Defendant shall be permitted to remain out of custody until the time of sentencing or until further order of the Court.

IT IS ORDERED setting the matter for entry of judgment of guilt and sentencing on June 15, 2026, at 2:00 PM, in Division 18. Estimated length of hearing is three (3) hours.

IT IS ORDERED that a presentence report be prepared by the Adult Probation Department.

Defendant is directed to cooperate with the probation department in the preparation of the presentence report.

IT IS ORDERED that the trial date set for August 4, 2026, in Division 18, is vacated.
