Statement of Probable Cause continued:

DV Relationship: The victim, [REDACTED] and the offender, Alex Barnett have been married for the past 12 years. They have a child in common and they live together. On 6/3/2024, the victim and Alex argued over the TV volume in front of their child. Alex grabbed the victim's hair. The victim left the house with the child and stayed with a friend. On 6/5/2024, the victim returned to the house to start her work around 4:30. She went into the bathroom to take a shower. She locked the door since they had an incident on 6/3/2024. Alex opened/unlocked the door. Alex started to grab her purse, and the victim exited the shower to retrieve her wallet. Alex placed a hand over the victim's neck and impeded her breathing. She remembered being squeezed but blacked out shortly after. She said she felt the pressure around her neck for about 3 seconds. She remembered kicking him. When she woke up Alex was gone. The victim had injuries to her neck consistent with the strangulation. Later, Alex agreed to meet with investigators at his probation officer's office. Post-Miranda, he said he argued with the victim two nights ago. He said a remote was broken. When asked, he said he pushed the victim today and left the house. He doesn't remember where he pushed her. Alex had scratches on his forehead and his left shoulder. Alex is over 300 lbs/6'2". The victim is 150 lbs.
