Statement of Probable Cause continued:

On 12/24/2025 Jeffrey Allen Ashworth was riding the SunTran bus near the front. Jeffery can be seen looking towards the back of the bus several times. At one point Jeffery gets up from his seat and walks to the back of the bus. Jeffrey pulls out a pocket knife and stabs the victim in the neck and shoulder area at least 12 times causing serious physical injury to the victim. Jeffery then walks back to where he was seated and waits for officers to arrive. Jeffrey admitted to stabbing the victim 12 times because the victim had called him "Red" and talking about him while sitting in the back of the bus.

Justification for Bond Recommendation:

Jeffrey admitted that he did not know the victim or met the victim before. From the video this appears to be a completely random attack without provocation. The victim is in serious but stable condition.
