MINUTE ENTRY

CHANGE OF PLEA / DONALD HEARING

Defendant present, in custody.

The Court questions the Defendant regarding his understanding of the terms and conditions of the plea agreement, the possible consequences thereof, and the constitutional rights he waives by entering the plea.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of AMENDED COUNT ONE: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON OR DANGEROUS INSTRUMENT a Class Three Nondangerous Felony, committed on or about August 14, 2024.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of AMENDED COUNT FOUR: DISORDERLY CONDUCT – WEAPON OR INSTRUMENT, a Class Six Nondangerous Felony, committed on or about August 14, 2024.

Defense counsel provides the Court with the factual basis for the plea, to which the Defendant concurs.

The Court incorporates the Grand Jury transcript as further factual basis.

THE COURT FINDS that the Defendant knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently enters a plea to the charges set forth in the plea agreement, and that there is a factual basis for the plea.

The plea is accepted and entered of record.

IT IS ORDERED setting the matter for entry of judgment of guilt and sentencing on May 12, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., in Division 16.

IT IS ORDERED that a presentence report be prepared by the Adult Probation Department.
