Statement of Probable Cause continued:

On June 8, 2026, Tucson Police Communications received a 911 call regarding an unresponsive male laying in the roadway near S Stone Ave and 17th St.

TFD arrived on scene and located [REDACTED] deceased. [REDACTED] had a laceration on his head, facial swelling, and bloody vomit around his face. A fixed blade knife was found in [REDACTED]s hand, but [REDACTED] did not have a sheath on his person to store the knife.

Officers canvassed the area for surveillance and discovered footage showing [REDACTED] back peddling away from another subject, engaging in what appears to be a fight, and falling to the ground. [REDACTED] appears to be backing away as the suspect is making slashing/punching motions while advancing toward him. The footage lasts for several minutes and shows the suspect standing over [REDACTED] toward the end of the altercation.

Surveillance shows the suspect, wearing tan pants, dark shoes, and a royal blue shirt.

Officers canvassed the area for any potential witnesses and contacted a person who had third-hand information that the suspect was [REDACTED]s brother, Gabriel Rosales.

Martin's family advised investigators of Gabriel's whereabouts. The family reported that they told Gabriel about the incident. While contacting Gabriel, a female subject told them that Gabriel and [REDACTED] were involved in a dispute and Gabriel was "punking" [REDACTED]. Gabriel told family he was with [REDACTED] a few hours prior and a person in a vehicle was following him.

When officers contacted Gabriel, he had a grocery bag in his possession containing clothing matching the surveillance footage. Additionally, Gabriel had a swollen right hand consistent with being in an altercation.

Gabriel denied having any involvement in his brother's death.
