Statement of Probable Cause:
On September 30, 2025, [redacted] and [redacted] reported to the Tucson Police Department that they were approached by a male, later identified as Olajide Shasanya, as they exited Park Place Mall. According to the victims, the male subject yelled at them to "stop" and "come back." As they did not recognize the individual, they continued walking in the direction of Broadway Blvd and Wilmot Rd. As they continued walking, they turned around and noticed he was no longer walking behind them. Shortly afterward, the victims reported hearing a vehicle horn and observed Olajide operating a black pickup truck in their vicinity. The vehicle passed by them multiple times. At one point, Olajide rolled down his window and shouted, "Get the [redacted] in the truck" in an aggressive manner, scaring the girls.

Statement of Probable Cause continued:
The victims recorded video of the truck as it was turning and then fled to a nearby McDonald's restaurant where they contacted police.
The girls articulated being fearful he would return and was attempting to kidnap them. Subsequent review of Park Place Mall surveillance footage confirmed the male had been following the victims throughout their time inside the mall. Surveillance also shows the male following the victims on foot as they exited the mall, bypassing his parked vehicle, and proceeded eastbound along Broadway. Surveillance showed him walking back westbound on Broadway, jumping over a retaining wall between the street and the parking lot to reach his vehicle, which he then drove toward the victims where he confronted them on the roadway.
