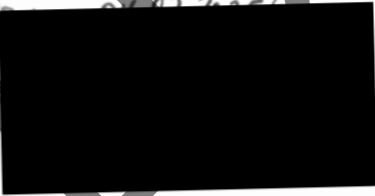

### Statement of Probable Cause:

On 03/30/2025 the victim Kevin Renguul was attacked by a pack of dogs across from the address of [REDACTED], which is located within Pima County AZ. The victim was found bleeding on the ground with several dogs around him. When emergency personnel arrived Kevin injuries were observed to be consistent with dog bites. He was Transported to UMC Banner Main hospital with life threatening injuries. According to the neighbors at the scene the dogs that attacked Kevin belonged to the address of [REDACTED]. The owner of the property/ residence was Martin Martinez. Mr. Martinez was found to have care and control of multiple dogs.

Statement of Probable Cause continued:

The dogs included German shepherd mixes. Pitbull mixes, /Cane corso mix, an Mastiff mix.

There are three previous reports to the Pima County Sheriff's Department involving Martin's dogs biting people(PCSD case #2300226213, 230405252, 250211196). Victims and neighbors describe the sane location/family complex and the same dogs.

Since 2022 Pima Animal Control has received eight additional reports of people getting bit by Martin's dogs. Some neighbors have also reported their animals being attacked or killed, sometimes on their own property by Martin's dogs.

On 03/30/2025 the victim was admitted into UMC Banner Main hospital in critical/ life threatening condition due to his injuries from the attack.

As of 04/0/2025 the victim Kevin has receive up to 15 blood transfusions ,and has gone through 2 surgeries to repair and treat the injuries inflicted. Kevin had to be intubated, and machines were needed to aid in his lung and kidney functions.

On 4/1/2025 Martin Martinez was arrested and charged for ARS 13-1201 Endangerment (F6) and Aggravated Assault with Vicious Animal (F5)

On the morning of 04/02/2025 the victim in this case (Kevin Renguul) succumb to the injuries inflicted by the attack from the canines owned by the defendant Martin Martinez . The Victim was pronounced deceased at Banner University Medical Center Main.
