Statement of Probable Cause continued:

Officers responded to [REDACTED] in reference to an assault call. The reporting party advised that her son had been assaulted by two people on his way to his bus stop for school. The victim is 14 years of age. The victim was walking by a truck and glanced over at the truck. The suspect approached the victim from behind and punched him in the face. The suspect demanded the victim's backpack and phone, and had him unlock the phone and the suspect called the victim's mother. The victim was knocked out unconscious and saw black for a couple of moments. He also had chipped teeth and had a laceration underneath his right eye. The laceration required either sutures or glue to shut.

The suspect was contacted in a yard at [REDACTED] and made statements about not knowing the victim was under 18 years of age and how he thought the victim was attempting to steal items inside the truck. The victim never attempted to steal anything from the truck and was simply walking by the truck when he was attacked.
