Statement of Probable Cause:

On 12/17/24, a search warrant was served at the residence of Oscar Cano. [REDACTED] During the service of the search warrant, approximately 1,000 to 2,000 blue colored M-30 stamped pills, which are commonly known to be counterfeit Oxycodone pills that are laced with Fentanyl, were found inside of a shed on the property. There was also a large amount of cash, approximately \$5,000, was found inside of the residence. A vehicle, which returned stolen, was also found on the property. Oscar stated that the vehicle was "abandoned by the insurance" and the insurance company never came to pick the vehicle up. Oscar is a confirmed prohibited possessor, and a total of 3 firearms were found inside of the residence. Oscar acknowledged the fact that he was in possession of the firearms, specifically a .38 caliber revolver,

Oscar was in possession of 2 spent .22 caliber shell casings in his pocket, there was a .22 caliber rifle found inside of his residence.

Oscar was arrested for possession of a narcotic, which is a class 4 felony, on Tuesday 12/17/24. Based of my knowledge, he was released on his own recognizance.
