Dear President [REDACTED]:

Pursuant to the Arizona Board of Regents Policy 5-401, et seq., and in accordance with the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, this letter is to inform you that, effective immediately, Sigma Chi is placed on ***Interim Loss of Recognition. Interim Loss of Recognition*** has been imposed pending the outcome of this investigation because it has been determined that your organization presents a substantial risk to members of the university community.

Interim Loss of Recognition prohibits hosting, attending, participating, and sponsoring any organizational activities and use of University facilities until the final disposition of this case.

Reportedly, on or around April 2, 2026, and April 11, 2026, Sigma Chi hosted events on campus at its fraternity house. The event on or around April 2, 2026, was registered as alcohol-free (dry) by Fraternity and Sorority Programs (FSP); the event on or around April 11, 2026, was not registered with FSP. Reportedly, at the events, UA students were provided with and consumed alcohol, and were knowingly and unknowingly given drugs. This alleged conduct is considered to have endangered UA students and reportedly resulted in multiple UA students being transported to the hospital.

Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below:

Code of Conduct/15. Alcohol - Violation of Board or university rules or applicable laws governing alcohol, including consumption, distribution, unauthorized sale, or possession of alcoholic beverages.

Code of Conduct/16. Drug - Unauthorized use, sale, possession, or distribution of any controlled substance or illegal drug or possession of drug paraphernalia that would violate the law.

Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm - Endangering, threatening, or causing physical harm to any member of the university community or to oneself, causing reasonable apprehension of such harm or engaging in conduct or communications that a reasonable person would interpret as a serious expression of intent to harm.

Code of Conduct/26. Violation of State or Federal Law - Commission of any offense prohibited by state or federal law or local ordinance.

Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules - Violation of, or attempt to violate, other rules that may be adopted by Board or by the university.

To discuss the pending allegations against the fraternity, a meeting must be scheduled with the Dean of Students Office. To schedule this meeting, please contact Dr. Whitney Mohr by April 28, 2026, at 4:00 PM. When we meet, I will answer questions and explain the Student Code of Conduct Disciplinary process. It is expected that Sigma Chi fully cooperate with this investigation. Any acts impeding the disciplinary process are prohibited. Any contact with the alleged victims for the purpose of intimidation or retaliation is prohibited and will result in disciplinary action. Should retaliation be alleged, it is a separate and distinct potential policy violation warranting another investigation. If this directive is violated, Sigma Chi may receive more restrictive sanctions, including, but not limited to, loss of recognition.
