Phi Delta Theta Update to Allegations at the University of Arizona

July 8, 2026 – [Tucson, AZ] – After a thorough investigation with the University of Arizona administration, Phi Delta Theta General Headquarters has issued a probation status to the Arizona Alpha chapter. The chapter has committed to reviewing and revising its new member education program, complying with all University sanctions, and maintaining regular communication with General Headquarters. The chapter will remain on probation until further notice.

Phi Delta Theta holds the safety of every member of the Fraternity as well as the individuals of the campuses and communities they are a part of, in the highest regard. The organization does not tolerate any actions that directly contradict the values and policies of the Fraternity and holds strict rulings against members and chapters that violate Fraternity expectations and the law.
