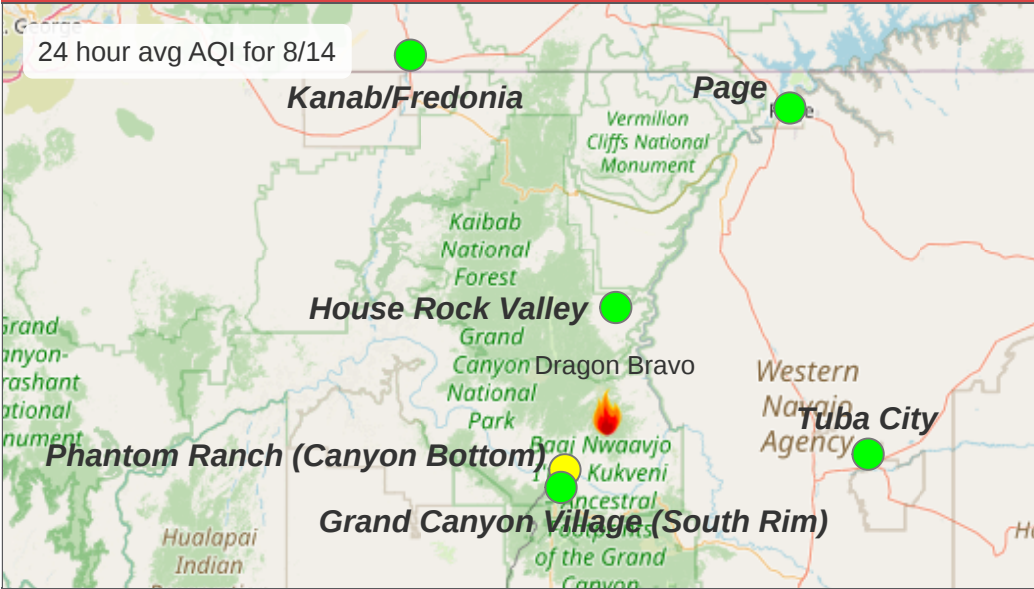

HEAT ADVISORY: An Extreme Heat Warning is in effect until 8 PM MST today for Grand Canyon Country below 4,000 feet elevation. ([more info](#))

FIRE

The **Dragon Bravo** fire is currently estimated at 144,432 acres and is 54% contained. Fire activity for the **Dragon Bravo** fire is expected to remain active.

SMOKE

Moderate to active fire behavior is expected once again today. Winds trend in the southwesterly direction, with the primary impact region from the Dragon Bravo being the canyon bottom. Expect generally MODERATE air quality and visibility to be impacted by haze.

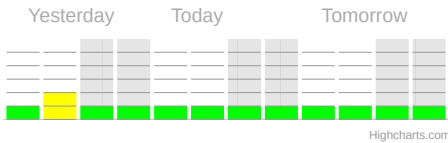
The remainder of the surrounding regions on the fire are expected to have generally GOOD air quality, including the Grand Canyon South Rim. Expect to see some haze from regional fires but little to no adverse smoke impacts at the surface. House Rock Valley may see some MODERATE air quality during peak burning periods in the afternoon.

There exists the possibility of dry thunderstorms in the region today, which may bring strong outflow winds. These winds could push the smoke in directions outside of the southwesterly general wind direction and may bring some MODERATE impacts to other local areas. Once these storms establish and precipitation begins to fall, expect the rain to clean the air and GOOD air quality to return.

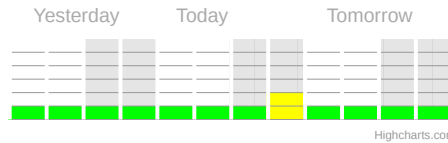
HEALTH STATEMENT

Smoke can be harmful to your health. Check with your doctor if there are any health concerns and monitor your local air quality conditions using the Fire and Smoke Map.

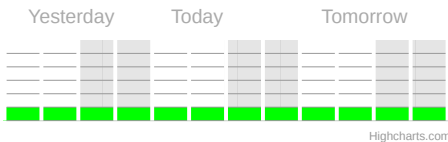
Grand Canyon Village (South Rim) Minimal smoke expected for the South Rim today. Expect generally GOOD air quality with the likelihood of rain.



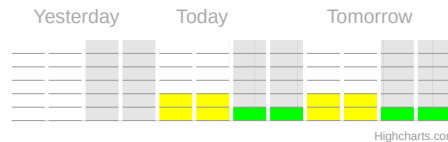
Page Breathing easy again in Page today. Expect GOOD air quality today, especially if rain manifests in the evening.



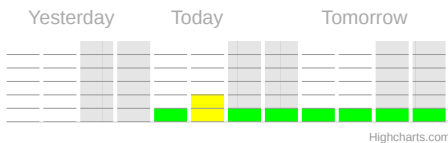
Tuba City Winds shift to the northwest and some rain enters the forecast today, limiting smoke. Expect GOOD air quality.



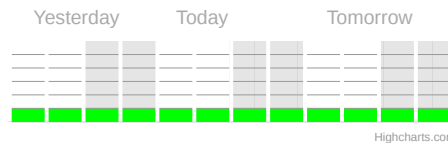
Phantom Ranch (Canyon Bottom) Another day of MODERATE smoke for the canyon bottom as fire continues to be active below the rim.



House Rock Valley Some smoke expected in the region, but with minimal surface impacts. Expect GOOD air quality, especially if it rains.



Kanab/Fredonia Another day of GOOD air quality conditions that are supported by active rainfall in the region.
