

HEAT ADVISORY: An Extreme Heat Warning is in effect until 8 PM MST Thursday for Grand Canyon Country below 4,000 feet elevation. An Extreme Heat Warning is in effect from 11 AM MST to 7 PM MST today for Marble and Glen Canyons.

FIRE

The **Dragon Bravo** fire is currently estimated at 144,432 acres and is 44% contained. Fire activity for the **Dragon Bravo** fire is expected to remain active.


SMOKE

Moderate to active fire behavior is expected once today. Winds trend in the westerly direction today, with the primary impact region from the Dragon Bravo being the canyon bottom. Expect generally MODERATE smoke conditions and visibility to be impacted by haze.

The remainder of surrounding regions on the fire are expected to have generally GOOD smoke conditions, including the Grand Canyon South Rim. Expect to see some haze from regional fire but little to no adverse smoke impacts at the surface. Tuba City may see some MODERATE smoke impacts during peak burning periods in the afternoon.

There exists the possibility of dry thunderstorms in the region today, which may bring strong outflow winds. These winds could push the smoke in directions outside of the westerly general wind direction and may bring some MODERATE impacts to other local areas.


Grand Canyon Village (South Rim) Minimal smoke impact expected for the South Rim today. Expect generally GOOD smoke conditions with chances of MODERATE.




Page Breathing easy again in Page today. Expect generally little smoke, some haze, and GOOD smoke conditions all day.




Tuba City Winds are coming from the west today, bringing elevated smoke levels to Tuba City. Expect MODERATE smoke conditions.



Phantom Ranch (Canyon Bottom) Another day of MODERATE smoke for the canyon bottom as fire continues to chunk around below the rim.



House Rock Valley Westerly winds keep the majority of the smoke to the southern extent of the valley today. Expect GOOD to MODERATE smoke.



Kanab/Fredonia Another day of GOOD air quality conditions. There will be some visible haze from surrounding wildfires.
