Statement of Probable Cause:

On 04/10/2026, Christian Isaiah Randall was racing with another vehicle while driving eastbound on Valencia. Randall was driving his 2013 Hyundai Genesis when he crashed into a 2018 Toyota Camry driven by _____ cutting the car in half. _____ was 33 weeks pregnant and had her 3 year old daughter, _____ in the back seat in a car seat. Both _____ and _____ were transported to Banner Main Hospital where _____ was soon pronounced deceased. _____ suffered a collapsed lung and other injuries as a result of the collision.

Witnesses stated that the car Randall was driving was racing with a dark colored Dodge Charger and was driving about 90mph.

Statement of Probable Cause continued:

Randall's vehicle was taken into custody and was downloaded after obtaining a telephonic search warrant. The speed limit on Valencia was 45mphs. A result of the download yielded the below speeds:

5.0 seconds prior to impact	83.26mph
4.5 seconds prior to impact	82.64mph
4.0 seconds prior to impact	82.02mph
3.5 seconds prior to impact	81.40mph
3.0 seconds prior to impact	80.16mph
2.5 seconds prior to impact	80.16mph
2.0 seconds prior to impact	81.40mph
1.5 seconds prior to impact	83.26mph
1.0 seconds prior to impact	85.13mph
.5 seconds prior to impact	87.61mph
0 seconds prior to impact	83.26mph

Randall stated he was not racing but rather was later for a preemployment drug test at Amazon. Randall stated he knew he was driving faster than the speed limit but claimed he was going with the flow of traffic. Randall further stated he had smoked marijuana the night before, but was not feeling the effects of it at the time of the collision.

Randall's excessive speeding demonstrated a blatant disregard for human life, as is confirmed by the death of an innocent 3 year old girl.

When the collision happened, [REDACTED] was on his bike. Debris from the collision hit him and he had to drop his bike and run for safety. [REDACTED] was not seriously hurt, but was close to being struck by the vehicles.

Justification for Bond Recommendation:
