Trial of this matter was held on August 9-August 18, 2021. The State appeared by Benton County Attorney David C. Thompson. The Defendant appeared by his attorneys, Jennifer J. Frese and Mark R. Brown.

The case was submitted to the jury at 1:20 p.m. on August 18, 2021. At 4:10 p.m., the jury returned into open court with their unanimous verdict. The jury returned the following verdicts:

Count 1 – “We, the jury, find the Defendant guilty of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree.”

Count 2 – “We, the jury, find the Defendant guilty of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree.”

Count 3 – “We, the jury, find the Defendant guilty of Lascivious Acts with a Child.”

Count 4 – “We, the jury, find the Defendant guilty of Lascivious Acts with a Child.”

Count 5 – “We, the jury, find the Defendant guilty of Assault with Intent to Commit Sexual Abuse.”

Count 6 – “We, the jury, find the Defendant guilty of Assault with Intent to Commit Sexual Abuse.”

The jury was polled, and all twelve jurors confirmed the verdict on the record.

The Court finds the jury's verdict to be in proper form, and the Court hereby accepts the verdict of the jury in this case.

Judgment and sentence is scheduled for October 1, 2021, at 1:30 p.m. The Benton County Sheriff shall transport the Defendant to the Benton County Courthouse for the sentencing on that date.

The Court informed the Defendant on the record of his right to file a motion for new trial pursuant to Iowa Rule of Criminal Procedure 2.24(2) as well as his right to file a motion in arrest of judgment, pursuant to Iowa Rule of Criminal Procedure 2.24(3).

The Sixth Judicial District Department of Correctional Services is directed to prepare a presentence investigation report. The Defendant is ordered to participate in a psychosexual interview through the Department of Correctional Services and the Department of Correctional Services is ordered to complete a psychosexual evaluation in conjunction with the preparation of the Presentence Investigation Report. The PSI will be made available for counsel and the Court online at least five days prior to the date set for sentencing.

The no contact order shall remain in full force and effect.

The Defendant's prior bond conditions are exonerated.

The Defendant shall be held without bail.
