- Paints and stains
 - Paint thinners
 - Aerosols
 - Yard chemicals
 - Gasoline and oil (Max 20 gal each)
 - Antifreeze (Max 10 gallons)
 - Pool chemicals
 - Corrosives
 - Adhesives
 - Rechargeable batteries (300 watts max)
 - Fire extinguishers (Max 2 per vehicle)
 - Road flares
 - CFL bulbs and Fluorescent tubes (max 15 per person)
 - High-intensity discharge lamps (HID) (Max 2)
 - Vape Pens with built in batteries (Max 2)

**Label automotive fluids as "pure oil" or "mixed with solvents or antifreeze."
Limits are per vehicle.*

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- Business/contractor waste
- Empty containers
- Containers larger than 5 gal.
- Lead acid batteries
- Alkaline batteries
- Cylinders & Propane tanks
- Medications
- Biohazards
- Electronics
- Appliances
- Ammunition & Explosives
- Aerial flares
- Incandescent and LED bulbs
- Asbestos
- Quantities over the maximum limits
