DISPATCH: TELL ME EXACTLY WHAT'S GOING ON.

CALLER TWO: One of our, one of the roommates is passed out and she was drunk last night and she's not waking up. Oh and I saw some man in their house last night.

DISPATCH: OK, I NEED SOMEONE TO KEEP THE PHONE, STOP PASSING IT AROUND.

CALLER ONE: Can I just tell you what happened pretty much?

DISPATCH: What is going on currently, is someone passed out right now?

CALLER ONE: I don't really know, but pretty much at 4 am...

DISPATCH: I NEED TO KNOW RIGHT NOW IF SOMEONE IS PASSED OUT. CAN YOU FIND

THAT OUT?

CALLER ONE: Yeah, come on Bethany, we gotta go check... But we have to.

(long pause)

CALLER ONE: Is she passed out?

Background/Male voice: Xana! (unintelligible. crying)

CALLER: (crying) Is she passed out, what's wrong? (pause...) She's not waking up.

BACKGROUND/MALE VOICE: Xana!

DISPATCH: OKAY, ONE MOMENT, I'M GETTING HELP STARTED THAT WAY.

CALLER: Okay, thank you (crying, frantic breathing)

(2:48 into call) BACKGROUND/MALE VOICE TO CALLER: Get out, get out, get out.

DISPATCH: OK AND HOW OLD IS SHE?

CALLER: She's 20.

DISPATCH: 20 YOU SAID?

CALLER: Yes, 20.

MALE CALLER: Hello?

DISPATCH: OK, I NEED SOMEONE TO STOP PASSING THE PHONE AROUND BECAUSE I'VE

TALKED TO FOUR DIFFERENT PEOPLE.

MALE CALLER: Sorry, they just gave me the phone.

DISPATCH: IS SHE BREATHING?

MALE CALLER: Hello?

DISPATCH: IS SHE BREATHING?

MALE CALLER: No (LONG PAUSE. Bethany, I need you to talk to them okay? I can't talk to

them, I need you to talk to them.

CALLER: Ok. Hello?

DISPATCH: OK, I'VE ALREADY SENT THE AMBULANCE AND LAW ENFORCEMENT. STAY ON THE LINE. IF THERE IS A DEFIBRILLATOR, SEND SOMEONE TO GET IT NOW AND TELL ME WHEN YOU HAVE IT.

CALLER: Say that again... There's police here right now

DISPATCH: OK. IF THERE IS A DEFIBRILLATOR AVAILABLE, SEND SOMEONE TO GET IT NOW AND TELL ME WHEN YOU HAVE IT.

CALLER: Do you have a defibrillator? (pause) Yes, he has one.

DISPATCH: ARE YOU TALKING TO THE OFFICER?

CALLER: Yes.

DISPATCH: OK, I'M GOING TO LET YOU GO SINCE HE'S THERE WITH YOU AND CAN HELP YOU.

CALLER: Ok, thank you – bye.
