## Prepping your home in case you need to evacuate

Inside the House: ☐ Have an emergency supply kit or evacuation bag ready ☐ Ensure you have a wildfire action plan ☐ Identify a place to go and routes to get there should you have to evacuate ☐ Shut all windows and doors, but leave them unlocked ☐ Remove flammable window shades, curtains and close metal shutters ☐ Remove lightweight curtains ☐ Move flammable furniture to the center of the room, away from windows and doors ☐ Shut off gas at the meter and turn off pilot lights ☐ Leave your lights on so firefighters can see your house in smoky conditions ☐ Shut off the air conditioning Outside the House: ☐ Move all flammable items inside the house (patio furniture, kids toys, etc.) ☐ Turn off propane tanks ☐ Move the BBQ away from the house ☐ Connect garden hoses to outside water valves ☐ Fill water buckets and place them around the house ☐ Turn off sprinklers ☐ Leave exterior lights on so firefighters can see your house in smoky conditions ☐ Put your emergency supply kit in your car ☐ Back your car into your driveway. Leave the windows and doors closed. Keep your keys on your person ☐ Put a ladder on the side of the house for fighters ☐ Seal the attack and ground vents with plywood □ Contact your neighbors
