KCRCC Demands Answers on Coeur d'Alene Police Reports' Contradictions in Townhall Incident

Coeur d'Alene, ID – The Kootenai County Republican Central Committee (KCRCC) calls for accountability following stark contradictions in two Coeur d'Alene Police Department (CDAPD) reports concerning the KCRCC legislative townhall on February 22, 2025. Detective Daniel Haley's March 6, 2025, search warrant affidavit claims Sheriff Bob Norris directed security to remove a disruptive attendee, stating, "No verbal identification was given." Conversely, his April 7, 2025, report asserts, "There was no direct statement by Norris stating he was asking for their assistance," adding, "At no time did [security] identify themselves."

Video evidence directly refutes both reports. Bodycam and townhall footage clearly show Sheriff Norris issuing five orders to the attendee to leave and security personnel identifying themselves twice as they enforced his directive. These discrepancies raise serious questions about the integrity of CDAPD's investigation into the incident, where a disruptive guest was lawfully removed under Idaho Code § 18-7008 after repeated interruptions.

"The truth is undeniable. Sheriff Norris gave clear orders, and security identified themselves, all on video," said Brent Regan, KCRCC Chair. "Detective Haley's reports apparently contradict each other and the evidence. Kootenai County deserves transparency"
