### RECREATION MILLAGE

**MILLAGE RATE - 1.67 MILLS**

#### WHAT IS IT?

The Recreation Millage pays for the people, places, and programs that keep Lafourche Parish families active and connected. It funds recreation centers across Lafourche Parish, maintains athletic fields and boat launches across the parish, and makes sure our parks stay open and well-kept.

#### VOTING FOR MEANS

- Keeps recreation centers open & staffed across the parish.
- Maintains parks, fields, & boat launches for families to use.
- Funds youth activities & summer programs for Lafourche kids.

#### VOTING AGAINST MEANS

- Recreation centers lose funding & could cut hours or close.
- Parks, fields, & boat launches go without upkeep.
- Summer programs & youth activities are eliminated.

### BUILDINGS & MAINTENANCE MILLAGE

**MILLAGE RATE - 2.52 MILLS**

#### WHAT IS IT?

The Building and Maintenance Millage keeps the buildings that run your parish government open, safe, and working. Lafourche Parish owns and operates 64 buildings across the parish, and this millage pays to maintain all of them.

#### VOTING FOR MEANS

- Keeps 64 parish-owned buildings safe, insured, & operational.
- Pays utility & maintenance costs for every government office.

#### VOTING AGAINST MEANS

- 64 buildings lose maintenance funding & insurance coverage.
- Utility costs & upkeep for government offices go unmet.
- Critical renovation projects are delayed or stopped.

### HEALTH UNIT MILLAGE

**MILLAGE RATE - 0.83 MILLS**

#### WHAT IS IT?

The Health Unit Millage helps pay for public health services that every person in Lafourche Parish can use. It supports the local health units that provide preventive care, immunizations, and health screenings — services that help keep our community healthy before problems become serious.

#### VOTING FOR MEANS

- Funds immunizations & health screenings for all residents.
- Supports women's health, prenatal care, & WIC services.
- Keeps preventive care affordable & accessible across the parish.

#### VOTING AGAINST MEANS

- Health screenings & immunization services are reduced.
- Women & families lose access to affordable preventive care.
- Local hospitals absorb more patients, & costs rise for all.
