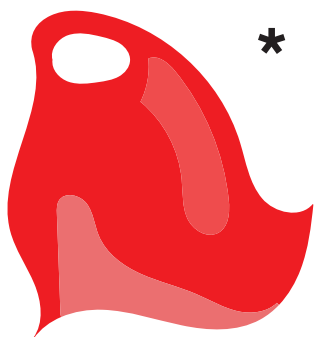


What Social Justice Warrior are you?

You're the Environmentalist. The environmentalist is very concerned with the status of the environment and making the earth their priority. You push for political and ethical change in regards to acknowledging that the environment is being oppressed by humans. Global warming and the conservation of nature are some of your top priorities within the movement. LMU often partners with Heal the Bay to put caring for the earth into practice, which aligns with LMU's Jesuit values. If you're still interested, the Environmentally Conscious Organization (ECO) is a club that fosters an atmosphere for environmentalists to join together under a common interest.

If you got mainly twos...

You're the Feminist. Sometimes known for being the loudest, feminists believe in political and social equality. For example, feminists hope to bring about fair access to healthcare and equal pay. Being a feminist is not exclusive to only women, but inclusive to all races, genders and sexualities.
