MISCELLANEOUS SPECIAL REGULATIONS APPLY

(CLASS A WILD TROUT STREAM SECTION STOCKED WITH TROUT)

- 1. Fishing with artificial lures, flies, streamers, natural bait, baitfish and fishbait is allowed. Spinning or fly fishing gear may be used in these waters.
- 2. Open to fishing from 8 a.m. on the opening day of trout season to midnight on the third Sunday in February.
- 3. Closed to all fishing from the third Monday in February to 8 a.m. on the opening day of trout season.
- 4. Brown Trout are Catch and Release Only. No Brown Trout may be killed or possessed on the waters managed under these regulations at any time.
- 5. All other trout species trout must be at least seven (7) inches long to harvest. The daily creel limit is five (5) trout (combined species) from 8 a.m. on the opening day of trout season in April to midnight Labor Day. From the day after Labor Day to the third Monday in February, Catch and Release Only; no trout of any species may be killed or had in possession on the waters managed under these regulations.
- 6. Taking baitfish or fishbait is prohibited.
- 7. A current trout permit is required.
- 8. These regulations apply to trout only; all other species inland regulations apply.

THE FOLLOWING TROUT SPECIES ARE COMMONLY FOUND IN THIS STREAM SECTION:

Brown Trout - Catch and Release Only

Identifying characteristics:

Dark spots on the back; red or orange spots on the sides; and the back and upper sides are dark-brown to gray-brown, with yellow-brown to silvery lower sides.





Rainbow Trout

Identifying characteristics:

Pink lateral stripe; dark spots on the back, head, body and tail; and the back and sides are silvery-gray to dark-green.

Golden Rainbow Trout

Identifying characteristics:

Yellow to orange body coloration; no spots on the body; and a pink to orange lateral stripe on the sides.
