WHAT TO EXPECT at Orthopedic Urgent Care at OAL

• At Urgent Care at OAL, a physician assistant will examine you, order x-rays if needed, provide a diagnosis and treat your specific orthopedic injury. If the physician assistant determines that a physician is needed for your issue, you will receive an expedited appointment with an orthopedic surgeon at the location of your choice.

The following will NOT be treated at Urgent Care at OAL:

- Prescription refills
- Individuals bleeding from an injury or an injury resulting from a burn or animal bite. Please proceed directly to a hospital emergency room or contact your current treating physician's office for guidance.
- Individuals currently being treated by another orthopedic surgeon for the injury in question. Please contact our office and we would be happy to schedule a second opinion appointment with one of our surgeons.
- Patients who need to address problems with a cast or surgical dress are encouraged to contact their treating physician for those issues.
