they took ten crocks of Apple sauce to Lancaster
sold it to Mr Diller for 2.00 pr crock, they
bald one and half gallon. Had to trade
for it but got just what we needed.
he got two dozen grain bags. some oil
cloth. coal shuttle. white wine for clothes
lines. etc. etc.

16th I cleaned our sitting room to day, we
now pretty well done with our house
cleaning for this season. got the drum
put in Pap's bed room.

17th Ironing. and churning. to day. sewing
some repairing a vest for Gilbert. etc

18th Pleasant day snow all gone. this afternoon
Gilbert Marion and I went to Steeleville took
our butter. had twelve lbs got 49 cts pr lb
Gilbert got him an over coat paid 16 dollars
for it. I got "water proof" enough for a
circular got 3 3/4 lbs paid 1.50 pr lb. This
is Thanksgiving day. Hiram's had Turkey
dinner. Esther and Dr Houston. Lydia Rakeson
Carrie Carter and John. and Emma and
Mary Jones were there. We came home to supper
