Dear Mr. Jason M. Hess:

This office is in receipt of your letter dated February 25, 2026, in which you explain that the Township is opposed to the issuance of a license allowing the brewing and sale of alcohol within the Township.

Please be advised, Section 472 of the Liquor Code allows voters of municipalities to limit the types of liquor licenses that can be issued within the municipalities. However, Section 472 does not apply to manufacturing licenses such as breweries. "Dry" municipalities may only restrict the issuance or transfer of retail licenses and distributor licenses. Therefore, a "dry" municipality cannot prohibit the issuance of a manufacturing license, such as a brewery license, to a qualified applicant.

Likewise, "dry" municipalities cannot restrict manufacturing licensees from selling alcohol as permitted under the law, nor can "dry" municipalities restrict the expanded privileges of manufacturers which were instituted by Act 39 of 2016.
