

The following is a statement sent to LNP by Brett Hambright, spokesperson for the district attorney's office:

"We cannot control what everyone does; however, we can make sure we handle situations properly when they surface.

We take all reports of workplace improprieties extremely seriously and, in this case, acted in concert with Human Resources to investigate, follow the facts, and come to an appropriate resolution for all involved. Additionally, our investigations have always included thorough reviews of relevant policies and recommended response actions by HR. This matter was referred to HR and all actions taken were in accordance with HR guidance and recommendations.

Whereas we respect and understand your questions for specifics in this matter, we cannot and will not release specifics about any personnel matter or incident without appropriate waivers from everyone involved, to include the county.

Further, because the county would be at the center of any potential legal action filed regarding release of information we direct your questions about specifics to the county Human Resource Office.

We can say, regarding your matter of inquiry, District Attorney Stedman inquired of the complainant if she was satisfied with the way the matter was handled by this office - to include the responsive action - and she informed us she was satisfied with respect to the Office of the District Attorney."
