


# Look Before You Leave

Spotted lanternfly threatens the Pennsylvania agriculture industry. The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture and the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) are asking for your help in the eradication efforts of this pest. Look for the insect before leaving a quarantined area, especially after walking or parking near a tree line.
