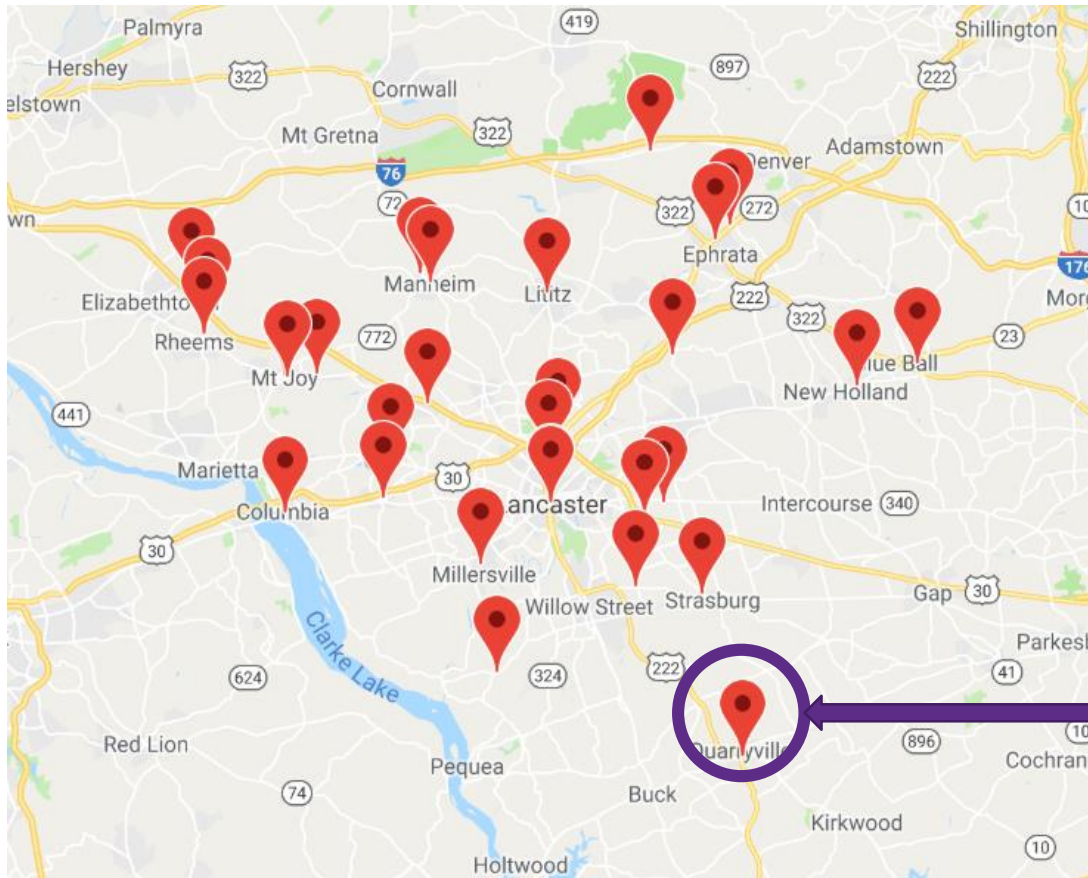

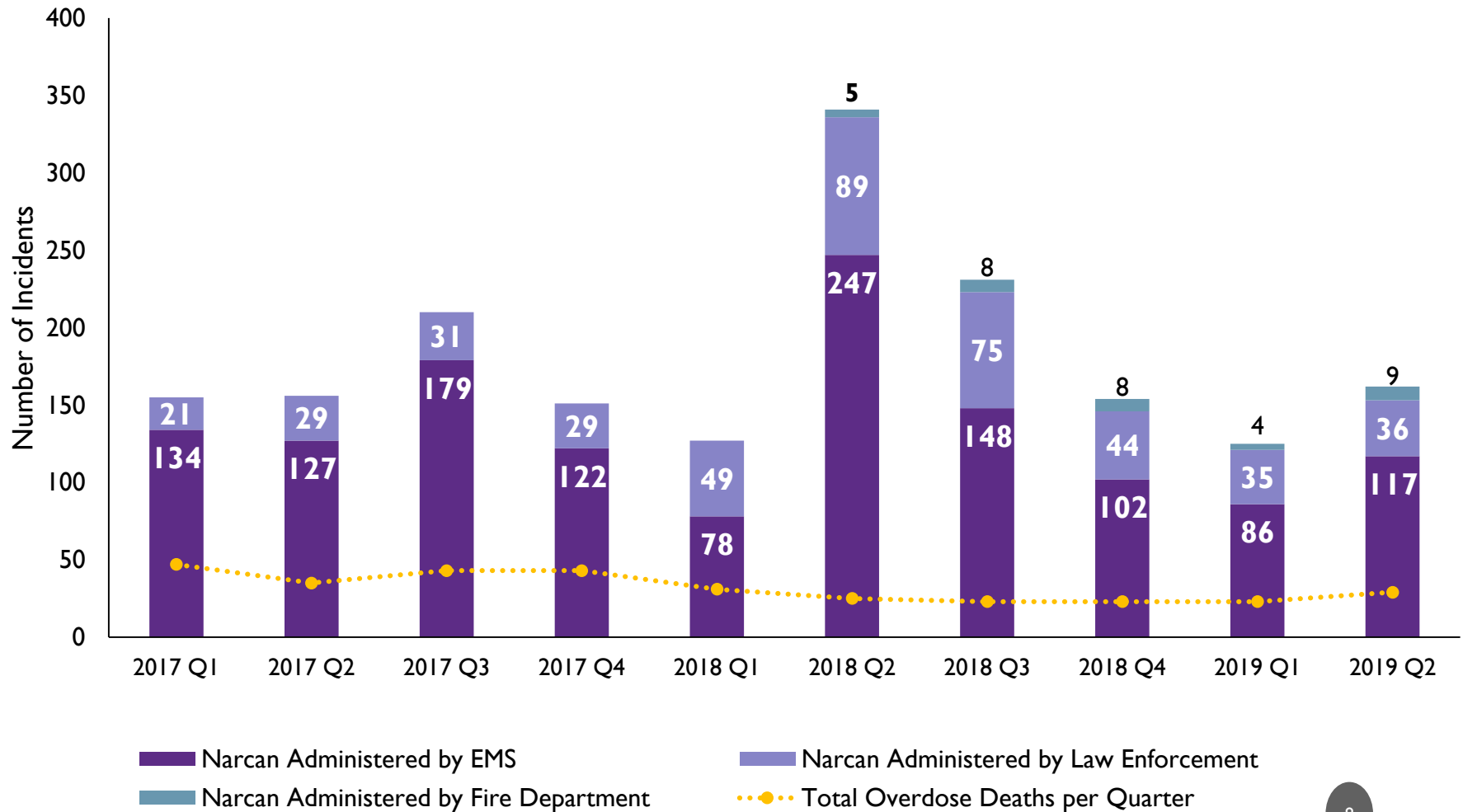

## By Quarter, January 2017-June 2019

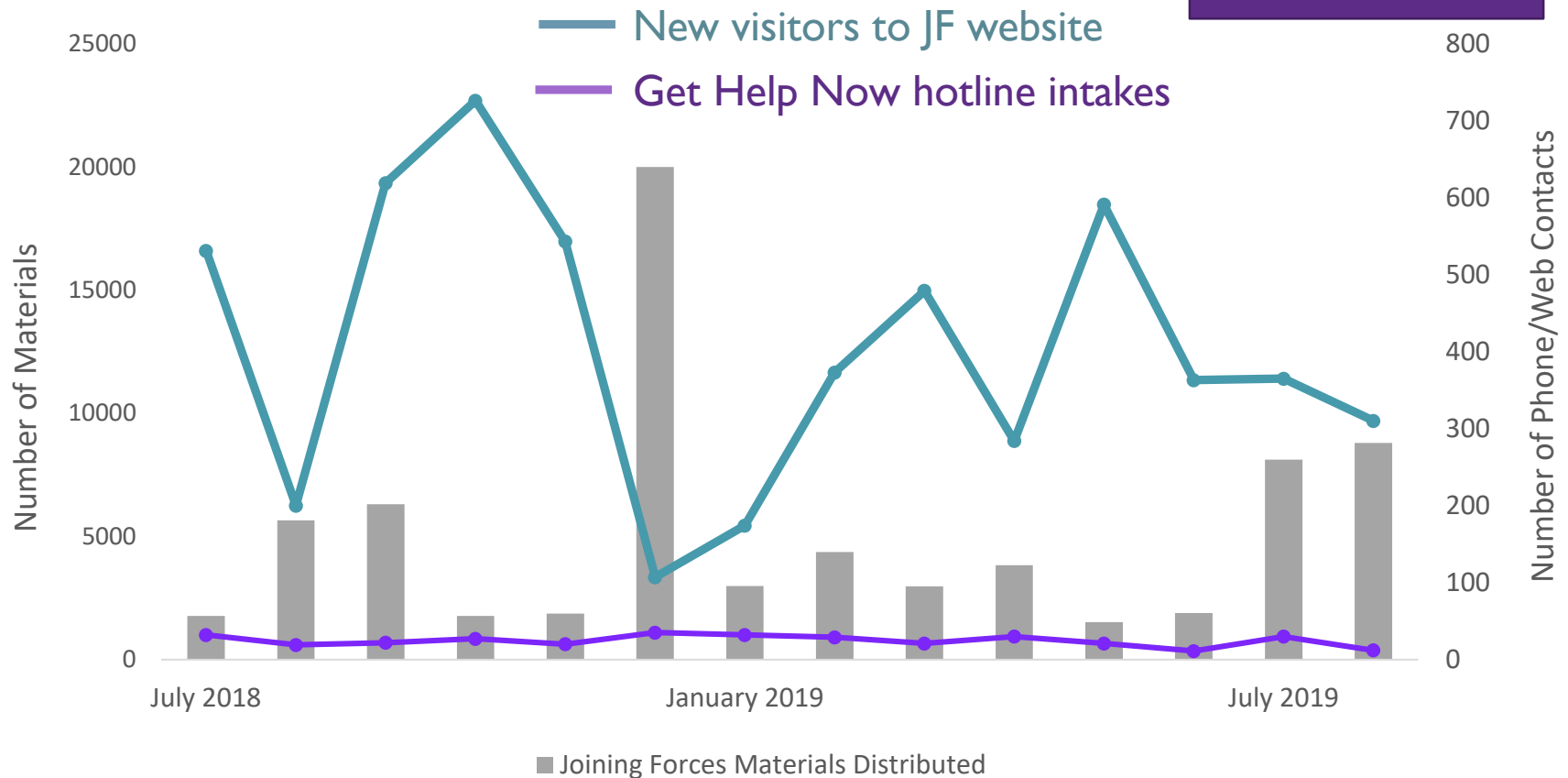

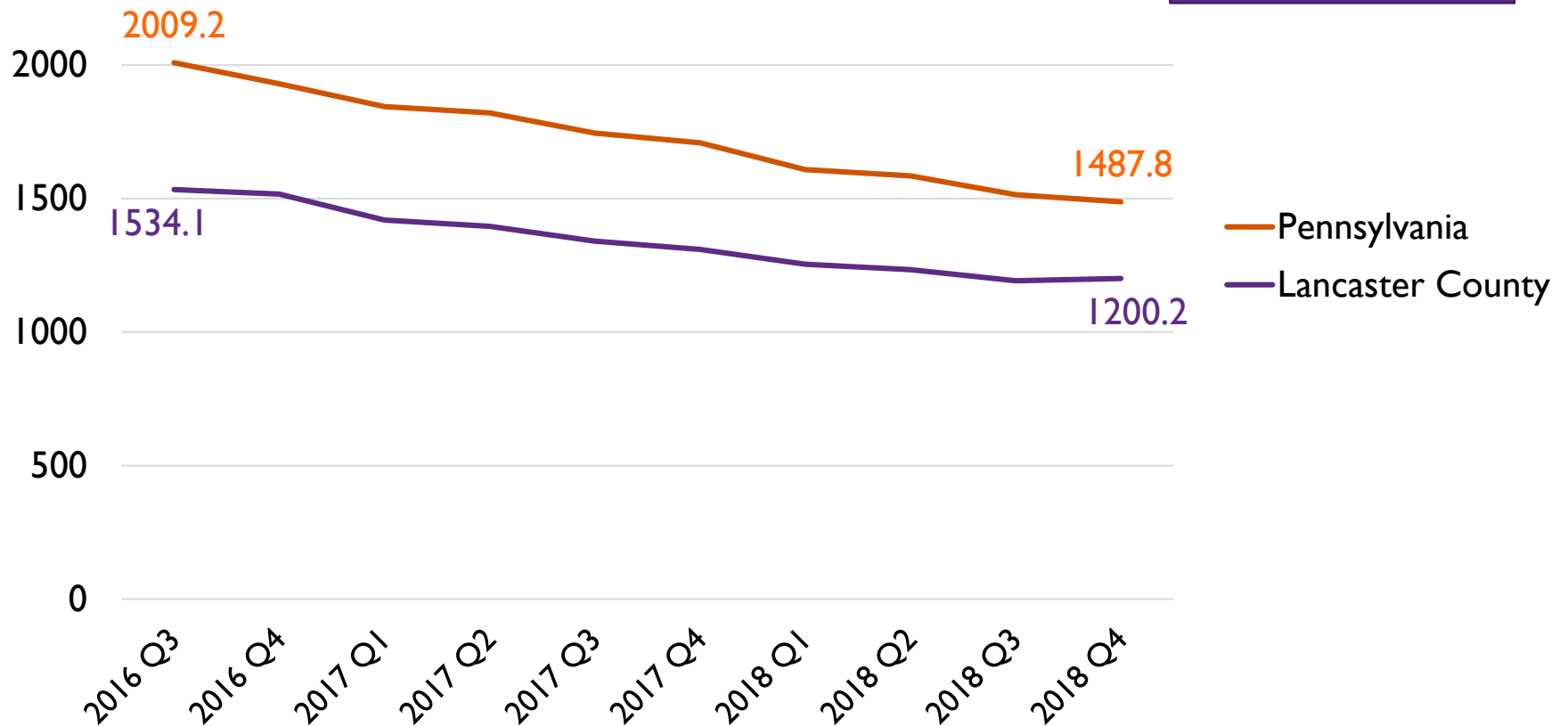

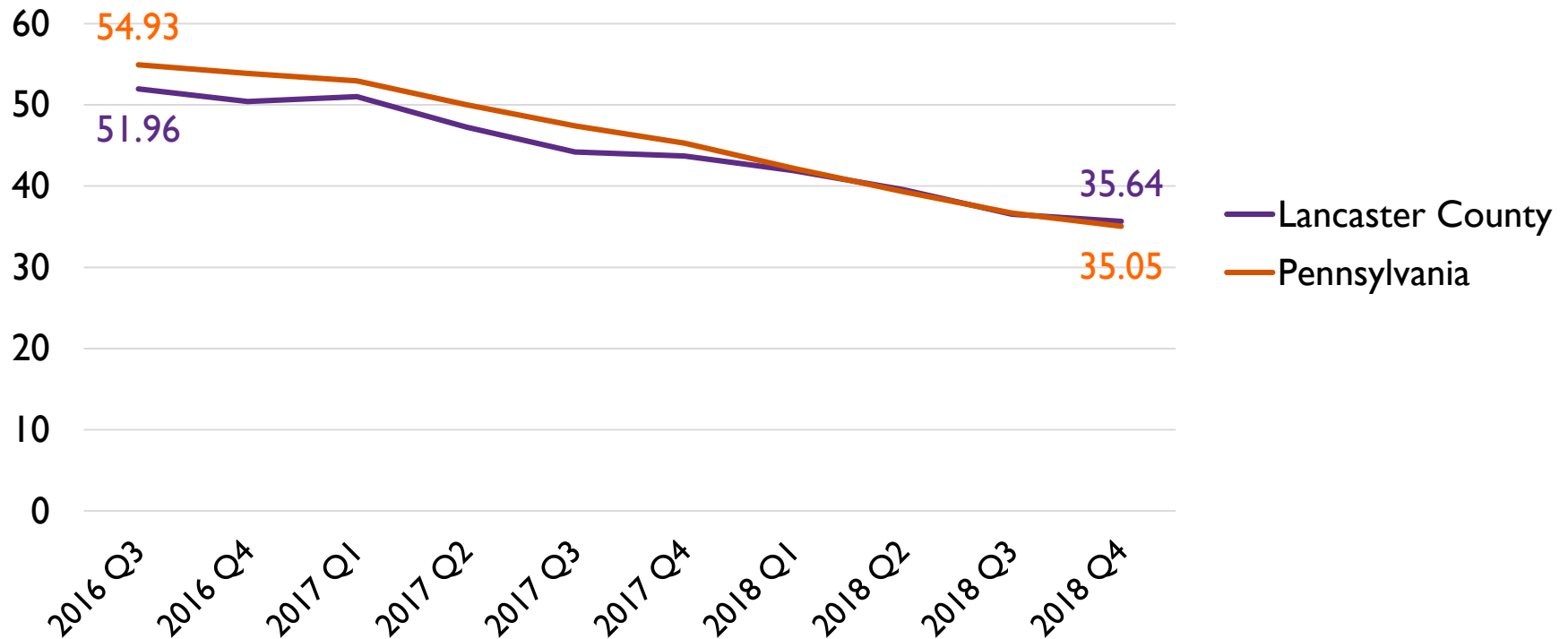

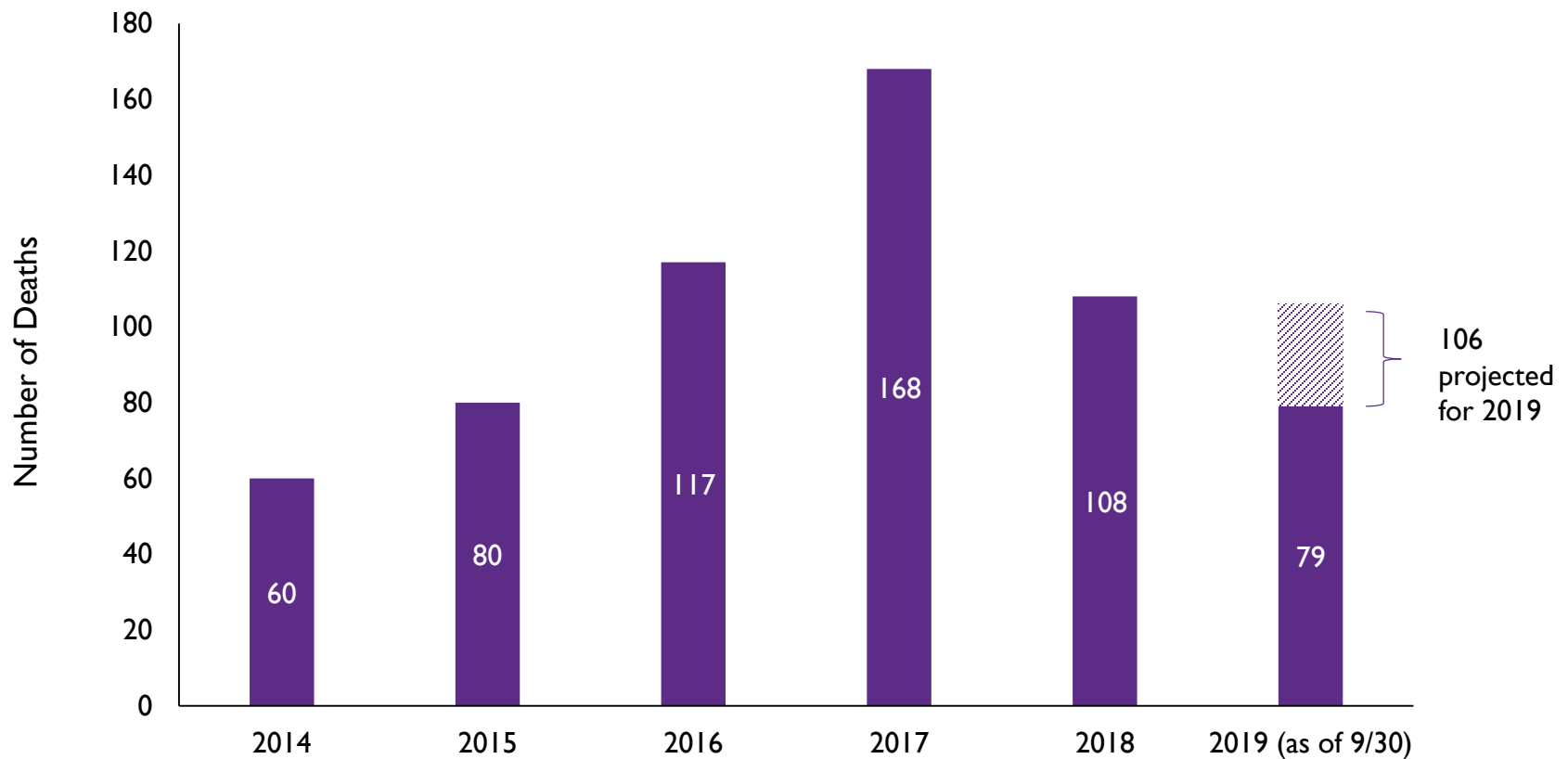
# Risky Opioid Prescribing

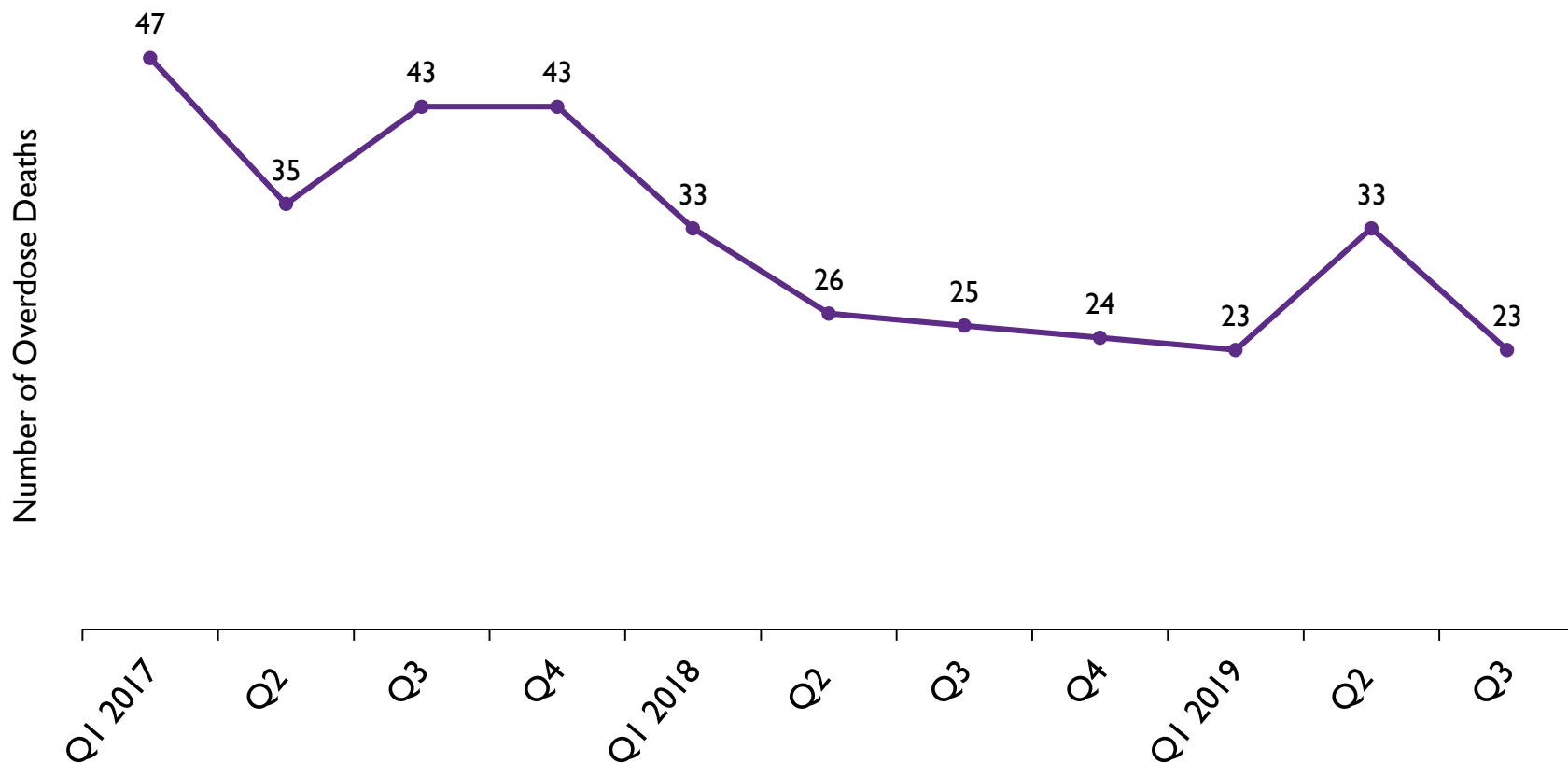

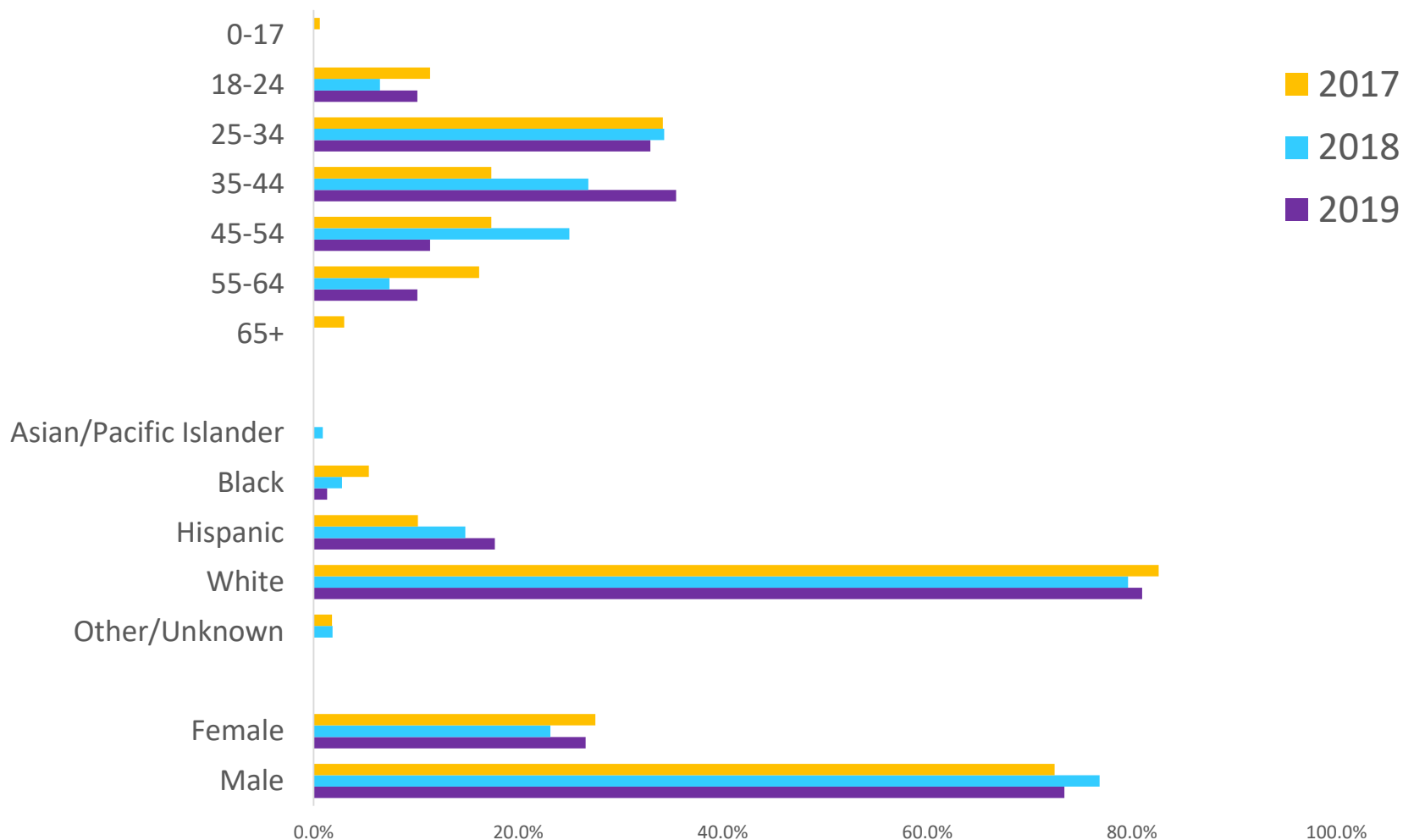
# Quarterly Overdose Deaths in Lancaster County, 2017-2019



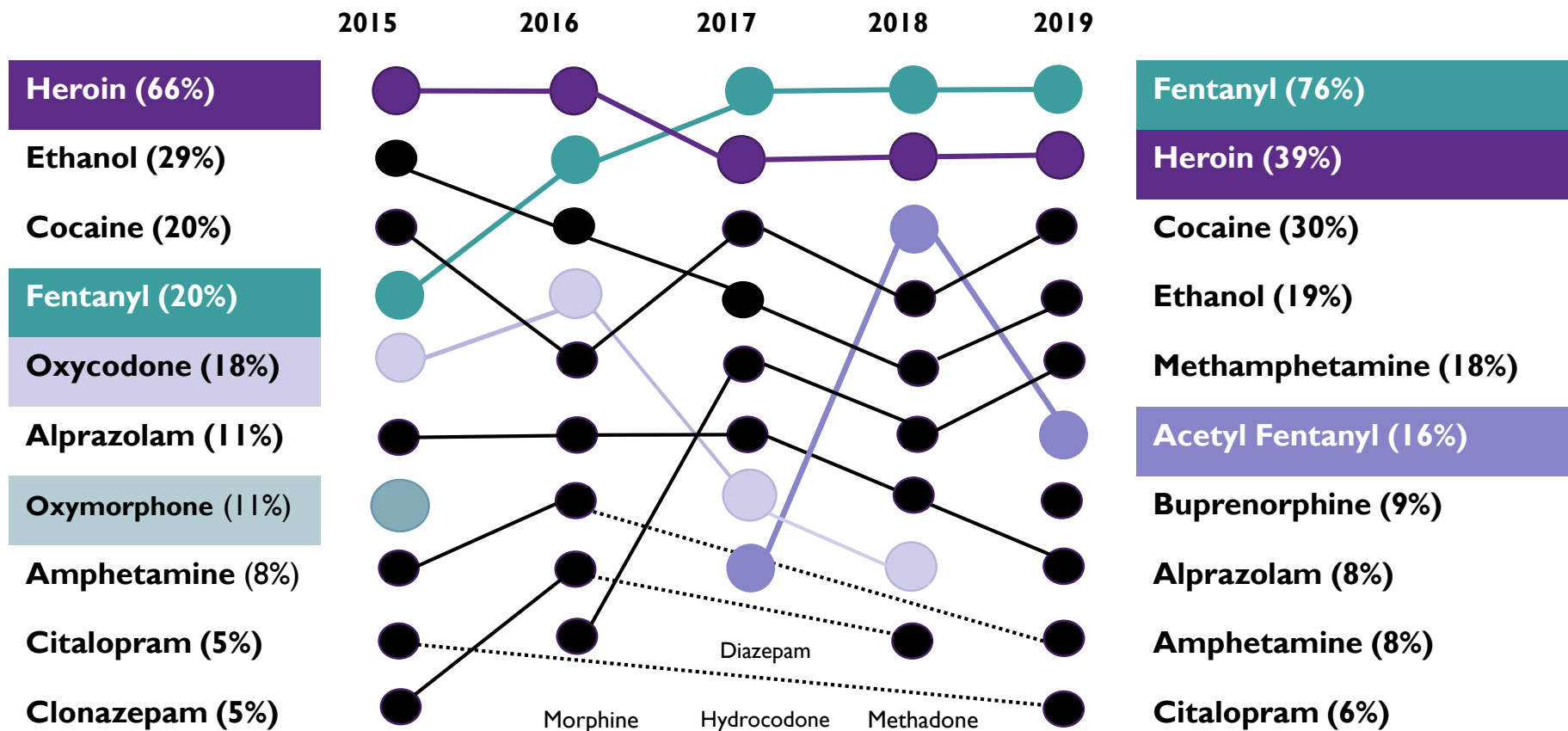
