- Coats for Kids, a program that distributes coats, scarves, hats, and gloves to 1600+ of Lancaster's children and adults for protection from freezing weather.
- Our **Family Services Program** has provided over 150,000 meals to over 11,000 persons during the Covid19 Pandemic. We have also been able to help with rent assistance (\$22,000-29 families) and other important provisions to help our neighbors get through this pandemic.
- Children's Programs, We offer character building programs to school age children via livestreaming/zoom, etc.
- **New Beginnings Program,** We provide 21 housing units and comprehensive services to men who have successfully completed our drug and alcohol rehab program.
- Community Outreach, Residents at Nursing homes/Boarding homes continue to be offered physical and spiritual support through visitation, food donations, correspondence and prayer availability.

Why do we do it? It's simple. We believe everyone in the neighborhood is part of the family; and we are dedicated to building a community where everyone is given the opportunity to live a better life. We want to be a church for you to grow in, a community for you to belong to, and a charity for you to turn to.
