

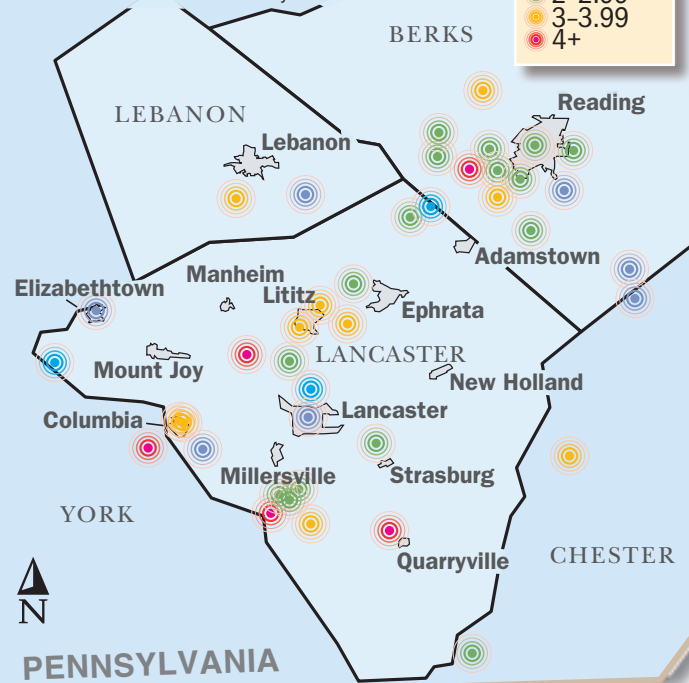
Recorded seismic events

Our area of eastern Pennsylvania is the most seismically active region in the state, although the reason is not clearly understood. Significant local quakes have erupted along a belt roughly connecting Berks and Lancaster counties*.
