NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE KANDI THOMPSON: Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of AMADOR COUNTY, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEMBER FOR DISTRICT 1 OF THE AMADOR COUNTY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES, in AMADOR COUNTY, California, and to demand election of a successor in that office.

The grounds for the recall are as follows:

1. Voting to fire Principal Laurie Carson without just cause;
2. Showing extremely bad judgment in allowing the superintendent to retaliate against employees that disagree with the superintendent;
3. Failing to place the interests of students, staff, and parents FIRST;
4. Failure to listen to her constituents;
5. Failure to respond to her constituent's concerns;
6. Failing to provide adequate financial oversight, contributing to a 1.5 million dollar shortfall;
7. Supporting Superintendent Slavensky's agenda that is moving the schools in the wrong direction;
8. Supporting a culture of fear, intimidation, and retaliation.

Kandi Thompson has put her loyalty to the superintendent above what is best for our students, staff, and parents. Ms. Thompson has proven beyond a doubt that she will support Superintendent Slavensky's agenda as shown most recently by her vote to fire Principal Laurie Carson. The people of this district deserve a board member that represents what the people want and not just a rubber stamp for the superintendent.
