Lt. Navarre provided us the audio recorded call to Amador County's non-emergency dispatch number from and his audio taped interview with her. The items were uploaded into Evidence.Com at the El Dorado District Attorney's Office.

On 05/26/2022, e-mailed Lt. Navarre the photographs she had taken on May 2, 2022, of injury. On 05/31/2022 Lt. Navarre provided the photographs to the El Dorado District Attorney's Office via e-mail and they were uploaded into Evidence.Com. I examined the photographs submitted by of right knee. I observed a small circular injury where the skin appeared to have been broken with redness in a circular pattern around it just above right knee. I know based on my training and experience that it was consistent with the type of injury that a taser probe would make.

On 05/31/2022 at approximately 1030 hrs, Supervising Investigator Joe Ramsey and I called on her cell phone. I audio recorded my initial call to and the following is a synopsis of that call. The audio was loaded into Evidence.Com at the El Dorado DA's Office.
