End of Conversation

At approximately 1300 hrs., Supervising Investigator Joe Ramsey, Amador County Sheriff's Lt. Jason Navarre and I contacted in a second floor conference room in the Administration Building located at 810 Court St, Jackson CA. The following is a summary of our conversation which was audio recorded and loaded into Evidence.Com at the El Dorado DA's Office

Interview

On May 02, 2022, at 5:00 pm, said she dropped off at the park and later picked him up at 7:07 pm that day. Coach approached the passenger side of her vehicle and said "just so you know so that you don't overreact, Coach Ryan was showing his taser to the boys and it accidentally went off and hit her son in the leg and damaged his pants." did not mention that had been injured. began to drive home when her son, disclosed to her that he had bled a little bit. He pulled up his pant leg and showed her a puncture wound on his lower right thigh just above his knee. She did not remember what their conversation was after that. When they arrived home, photographed the injury. At no time after the incident, did seek any medical treatment for injury. She said now the only visible mark that is left is a pink scar. had told her, the injury only stung briefly during the incident with some minor bruising two days following with no lingering pain since. She was not sure what to do at that point and had not lived in Amador very long. She said she did not want to start trouble.
