On February 24, 2020 the Jackson Police Department was contacted by the Amador County Unified School District who alleged their Director of Maintenance and Operations, 50 year old Robert Milligan, misappropriated funds in that he had purchased, on numerous occasions, fuel using a school issued fuel card for his personal vehicle and other use. A lengthy investigation was conducted by Jackson Police Investigator Doug Grey. Grey's investigation showed that Milligan was employed by the school district from July of 2018 until his resignation on February 21, 2020. During that time, Milligan allegedly used his issued fuel card to gas up his personal vehicle and personal gas cans approximately 54 times totaling close to \$5,000.00. As a result of Grey's investigation, felony charges were recommended to Amador County District Attorney's Office. An arrest warrant, charging Milligan with violations involving embezzlement by a public officer and grand theft, was issued on April 16, 2020. Milligan surrendered on June 1, 2020 and was cited and released. Milligan has been ordered to appear in Amador County Superior Court on October 9, 2020.
