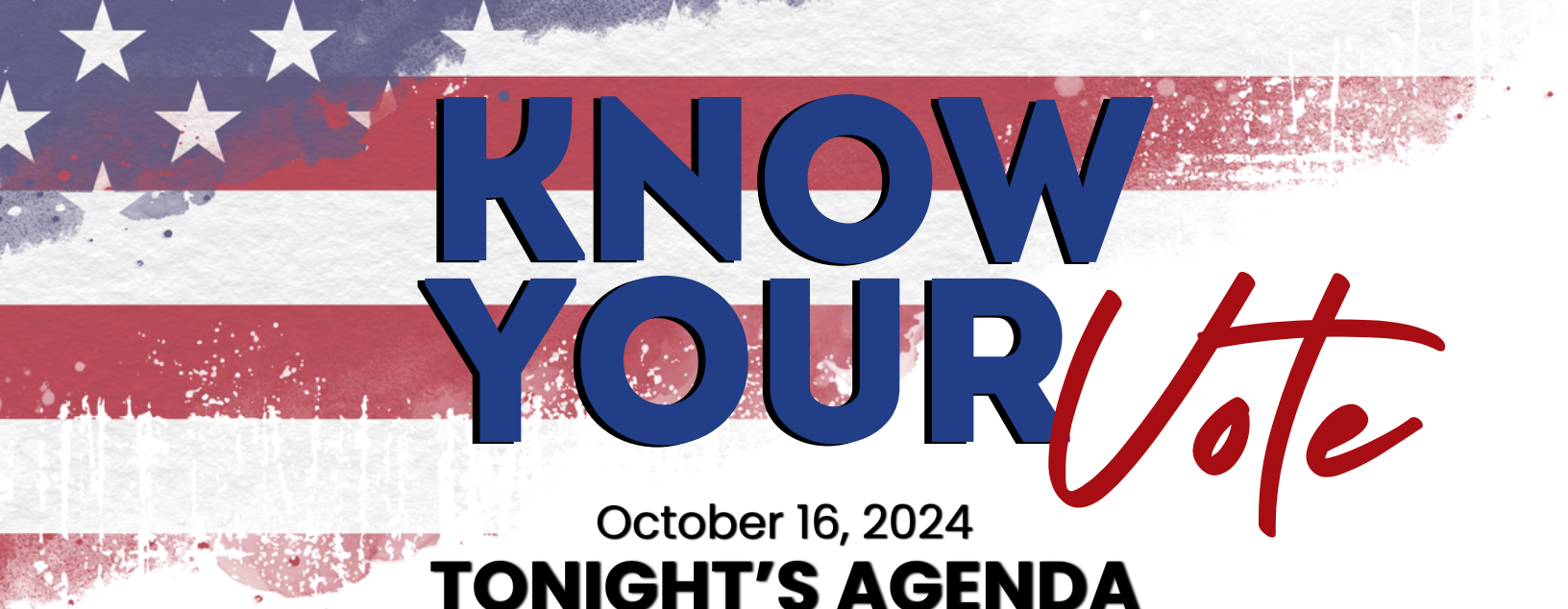

Liberty Hill ISD Ballot Measures

Proposition A: Funding for Liberty Hill Schools

"Ratifying the ad valorem tax rate of \$1.2269 per \$100 valuation in the Liberty Hill Independent School District for the current year, a rate that will result in an increase of 21 percent in maintenance and operations tax revenue for the District for the current year as compared to the preceding year, which is an additional \$13,334,196."

Proposition B: Attendance Credit Election

"Authorizing the Board of Trustees of the Liberty Hill Independent School District to purchase attendance credits with local tax revenues."

City of Liberty Hill Ballot Measure

Proposition A: Home Rule Charter



Voters can choose to vote for or against Proposition A on the November City ballot. Proposition A would establish a Home Rule Charter for the City of Liberty Hill.

WHAT IS A HOME RULE CHARTER?

A Home Rule Charter serves as a city's constitution and is allowed once a population reaches 5000. Home Rule is the privilege of citizens at the grass roots level to manage their own affairs with minimal interference from the State. Home Rule assumes that government issues should be solved at the level closest to the people.
