- The increase in the use of cell phones and personal communication devices by students during the school 1
- 2 day has become a significant distraction in the school environment and is impeding student learning.
- Accordingly, subject to the exceptions set forth in this policy, students may not use or possess cell phones 3
- or personal wireless communication devices while on campus during the regular school day. 4
- TCA defines wireless communication devices as a portable wireless device that has the capacity to 5
- 6 provide voice, messaging, or other data communication between two (2) or more parties.
- 7 A student may, however, be permitted to utilize a wireless communication device under the following circumstances: 8
- 9 1. In case of emergency;

- 2. When authorized by a teacher
 - 3. To manage the student's health, as documented in the student's individual healthcare plan;
 - 4. When the possession or use is required by the student's individual education program, 504 plan, or individual learning plan; or
 - 5. When the device is being used by a student with a disability for the operation of assistive technology to increase, maintain, or improve the student's functional capabilities.
- All staff will be informed if a student has an identified exception and will accommodate the student 20 accordingly. 21

PENALTIES 22

- Consequences for cell phone violations will be issued in alignment with the HCS Code of Acceptable 23
- 24 Behavior. The consequences for violating this cell phone policy may be in addition to any other
- violations of the HCS Code of Acceptable Behavior. 25
- Wireless communication devices are brought to school at the student's own risk. School staff are not 26
- liable for lost or stolen cell phones and are not responsible for conducting any investigations regarding 27
- the loss of a student's electronic device. 28
