The Hamilton County General & Policy Survey conducted 406 interviews with a survey design of 300 IVR Landline and 100 Online Mobile Interviews from July 5 July 7. The scientific random poll sampled 22,000 likely county mayor general election voters who voted in at least 1 of the last 3 contested county mayor general elections elections . The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.1 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.
