Re: Public Comment Period for the Valley North Transmission Line Project

To the Valley North Project Team:

We are writing on behalf of constituents who have expressed serious concerns about the Valley North Transmission Line Project and the current deadline for public comment. It is our belief that the communities most directly affected deserve adequate time to review and understand the proposed routes and provide meaningful input.

Potentially affected residents have identified several reasons why an extension is necessary, most notably the size and complexity of the project. The proposed transmission line extends 260 miles across three states, while the study segments total more than 1,000 miles. As the proposed lines move through Western Loudoun, they may affect historic communities, agricultural operations, and thousands of residents. Although we appreciate Valley Link's community outreach efforts, many residents are only now becoming aware of the project and need additional time to document its potential impacts.

It is our duty to ensure that every affected constituent has a meaningful opportunity to be heard. The concerns we are hearing directly from residents align with the recent requests you received from Save Rural Loudoun and other community organizations to extend the public comment period. We join them in respectfully requesting an extension of the deadline for public input on the Valley North Transmission Line Project.
