Dear Ms. Biberaj and Sheriff Chapman,

By now you are aware of an incident that took place outside of Trump National Golf Course in Sterling, Virginia on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020. A man without a mask, with a "Trump blowup toy" attached to his waist, purposefully and forcefully coughed on two women who were protesting the President. The two women were both wearing masks and had not approached the man.

We are in a hundred-year, highly contagious, worldwide pandemic of a deadly virus that has killed more than 250,000 Americans. All of the Loudoun County numbers are headed in the wrong direction. Science has confirmed, and it has been widely reported, that wearing a mask is a very effective way to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Conversely, not wearing one and not socially distancing, is clearly irresponsible. Willfully coughing in someone's face is clearly dangerous.

Given these facts, I request that a full investigation be completed to ascertain if the man seen coughing in the video has violated any laws, and if so are charges applicable. I further request, because our constituents will reach out to me and my colleagues on the Board of Supervisors for information on this matter, you provide the Supervisors with updated information.
