The Investigator will:

- Conduct criminal and civil investigations.
- Assist with trial preparation, including witness interviews, evidence review, subpoena service, and courtroom assistance.
- Attend court proceedings and provide investigative support.
- Coordinate and assist with law enforcement agencies in major case investigations.
- Collect forensic evidence, including digital evidence, and assist in digital evidence authentication and evaluation.

Accordingly, this position may be structured as either a permanent part-time position or a flexible-hours arrangement.

- Technical ability to preserve, collect and interpret digital data and forensic evidence.

- Drone pilot qualified.
- Formal training in digital phone data extraction.
- Instructor credentials preferred.
- Substantial experience with felony investigations as lead investigator.
