for individuals interested in being eligible for a future appointment to a deputy sheriff position.

Testing is required of all non-ILEA certified candidates and ILEA certified candidates with more than a 180-day break in service.

In order to participate in testing an online civil service application must be submitted by Monday, November 10, 2025.

Check in begins at 7:30 a.m. November 22nd with testing beginning promptly at 8:00 a.m.

Physical fitness testing location will be the Maquoketa High School Track and Field, 600 Washington Street, Maquoketa, IA 52060. **NOTE**: the Track is to south of the high school, candidates will need to drive around to the back side of the high school and out-lying buildings (or enter from S. 5th Street).

Applicants that successfully complete the physical fitness tests will proceed to take the written POST exam at 10:00 a.m. Location of written testing will be provided to those successfully completing the physical fitness testing.

Iowa Certified Officers in good standing (with no more than a current 180-day break in service) may submit a civil service application at any time and are not required to take the physical fitness or POST testing.
