



# The Delwood Community School District, state funding and property tax rates...

**HOW THIS GRAPHIC WORKS:** This graphic explains the relationship between school enrollment and Supplement State Aid (money the Iowa Legislature provides school districts, known as SSA) and how the two could affect the Delwood School District's finances and local property tax rates. It also shows what a 1.75% SSA increase for the 2026-2027 school year, which the Iowa Senate approved earlier this month, could mean for educators, students and taxpayers.



The information below shows how the Delwood School District's certified enrollment this school year and a 1.75% increase in SSA would affect the district's finances next year.



\* Includes additional \$5 per student approved by Iowa Senate.

A net revenue gain of \$24,940 for the district
