I. CONSENT AGENDA

It is ordered to approve the Consent Agenda for July 27, 2026, McCracken County Fiscal Court.

II. BUDGET TRANSFERS

It is ordered that the necessary cash transfers, in the amount of \$_____ be made in order to pay County bills and payroll approved July 27, 2026.

III. ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

It is ordered to approve the Voucher Claims Register from July 13, 2026, to July 27, 2026, to show County bills in the amount of \$_____ were paid.

IV. COURT ORDERS

A. It is ordered that the section of Herzog Road beginning at Schneidman Road and ending 409 ft east of Schneidman at the dead end be renamed as Herzog Drive as requested by petition of the residents. Said petition fulfills the requirements of KRS 179.330(2), and a copy of the petition is included as an Exhibit to this Order.

- B. It is hereby ordered that the McCracken County Fiscal Court approve the Website Modernization Proposal Option #2 with Thicket Studio for a new McCracken County Website in the amount of \$39,000.00. It is further ordered that the Judge Executive be authorized to enter into a contract and sign all necessary documents for same; and the Treasurer be authorized to pay invoices.
- C. It is ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to request a draw down from CDBG Grant# 26-036 for Four Rivers CenterPoint Behavioral Health in the amount of \$200,000 and release those funds.
- D. It is hereby ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign a resolution and contract for professional services with the Purchase Area Development District to administer a Community Development Block Grant #26-036 for the construction of a new facility for the McCracken County Health Department.
- E. It is hereby ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign a resolution authorizing the submittal of a 2026 Community Development Block Grant Application in the amount of \$850,000.00 to the Kentucky Department for Local Government together with such other Agreement, instruments, or certifications which may be necessary, all relating to the construction of a new facility for the McCracken County Health Department.
- F. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign the annual service agreement with GPEDC (Greater Paducah Economic Development Council), this agreement outlines the payment of funds appropriated in the FY 26/27 budget. It is further ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to make payments related to the same.
- G. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign the annual service agreement with Barkley Regional Airport, this agreement outlines the payment of funds appropriated in the FY 26/27 budget. It is further ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to make payments related to the same.
- H. It is hereby ordered that the McCracken County Fiscal Court approve the 2026 Kentucky Waste Tire Management Program Agreement. It is further ordered that the Judge Executive be authorized to enter into a contract and sign all necessary documents for same.
- I. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign a resolution of the Fiscal Court of McCracken County officially declaring the intent of the County to reimburse itself for the prior payment of particular capital expenditures at the Paducah-McCracken County Convention & Expo Center using the proceeds of an issue of tax-exempt obligations.

- J. It is hereby ordered that the request for proposal regarding applicants interested in submitting a proposal for a cable communications franchise, as shown on the attached document, be approved. In summary, the order agrees that the McCracken County Fiscal Court approves the Request for Proposals Official Application Form.
- K. It is ordered to pay the invoices dated June 18, 2026, and July 8, 2026, to James Sanders Nursery for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$56,146.19. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- L. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated July 7, 2026, to Global Industrial for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$6,371.76. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- M. It is ordered that \$8,484.38 be paid to the Kentucky State Treasurer for 2026/2027 funds mandated under House Bill 388 and HB 337 (effective July 1, 1998), which requires "the fiscal court of all counties . . . annually appropriate twelve and one-half cents (0.125) per capita of the population of the county . . . to pay court orders entered against counties for the defense of the indigent".
- N. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign Addendum A to the original Software Management LLC agreement for the Clerks Office. This extends the original contract expiration date of August 31, 2026, to June 30, 2027.
- O. It is ordered that the following vehicles previously used by the McCracken County Sheriff are declared as surplus to be sold at a future auction. The first two vehicles were paid for with drug funds, and those monies will go back to that fund.

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-11**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY MCCRACKEN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05, SETTING FORTH THE PREVIOUS FORM OF THE MCCRACKEN COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND ENACTING A REPLACEMENT ADMINISTRATIVE CODE CONTAINING ALL AMENDMENTS ENACTED SUBSEQUENT TO THE INITIAL PASSAGE OF MCCRACKEN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05.

Summary: The present action is mandated by KRS 67.710 and KRS 68.005 and operates to repeal in its entirety the current McCracken County Administrative Code as previously enacted by Ordinance 2024-05 and containing the amendments enacted subsequently to its initial passage. The present action allows the full incorporation of all such subsequent amendments into a single self-contained code for ease of administration and more effective and efficient notice of and compliance with its provisions
