EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the County of Graves is under a State of Emergency causing extreme and extenuating conditions, which may lead to extra ordinary fire hazards; and

WHEREAS, these conditions endanger the public health and safety and threaten the natural resources of the Commonwealth; and

NOW THEREFORE, I, Jesse Perry, Graves County Judge Executive, by the virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby order and direct the following:


1. All open burning within the County of Graves is prohibited until further notice.
2. All local law enforcement personnel shall enforce this Executive Order per KRS 39A.180.
3. Any person who violates the ban on open burning established in this Executive Order shall be subject to penalties provided under KRS 39A.90, and/or such penalties as are provided under state law.
4. This Executive Order shall become effective at 12:00 p.m. CST on September 2, 2025 and remain in effect until further notice.

This includes but not limited to:

1. Fires for burning forest, grass, crops, woodlands, marshes, or other similar areas.
2. Fires for burning leaves or debris.
3. Fires for campfires, bonfires, and warming fires.
4. Open pit cooking and charcoal grills.
5. Use of fireworks and welding may also be prohibited or regulated.

A copy of this Executive Order will be released to Media Outlets, and local emergency response agencies.
