Said accused knowingly and willfully opposed these requests and commands and never provided the requested identification.; on 05/24/2019 at 11:00 AM at S Fairground St/Haley St, Marietta, County of Cobb, GA 30060 commit the offense of OBSTRUCTION/HINDERING LAW ENFORCEMENT(M) violating O.C.G.A, Section 16-10-24(a), said accused did knowingly and willfully resist, obstruct, or oppose a law enforcement officer in the lawful discharge of the officer's official duties to wit: During a dispatched traffic accident, said accused refused to comply with your affiant's lawful instructions. Said accused was asked and told to exit the vehicle. Said accused was given this lawful command 8 different times and refused to comply.; on 05/24/2019 at 11:00 AM at S Fairground St/Haley St, Marietta, County of Cobb, GA 30060 commit the offense of OBSTRUCTION/HINDERING LAW ENFORCEMENT(M) violating O.C.G.A, Section 16-10-24(a), said accused did knowingly and willfully resist, obstruct, or oppose a law enforcement officer in the lawful discharge of the officer's official duties to wit: Said accused was told to exit the vehicle and refused to comply. Officer's grabbed said accused to remove him from the vehicle. Said accused actively resisted the lawful command by grabbing the center console and pulling himself toward the center of the vehicle. Officer's were able to remove said accused from the vehicle. Said accused continued to actively resist and pulled his hands toward the front of his body as officer's were attempting to handcuff said accused.; and affiant makes this affidavit that a warrant may issue for the arrest of the accused.
