ORDER REVERSING MARCH 26, 2020 DECISION OF ELECTIONS BOARD


This matter came before the Court on Petitioner Craig Owens' Emergency Petition filed on April 2, 2020 seeking to reverse the March 26, 2020 decision of the Cobb County Board of Elections and Registration disqualifying Owens as a candidate for Sheriff of Cobb County. Having read and considered the pleadings of the Petitioner and Respondents, the record before the Elections Board, the parties' respective hearing briefs, and having heard argument of the parties on April 6, 2020, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED for the reasons stated in open court:

The March 26, 2020 decision of the Cobb County Board of Elections and Registration regarding Craig Owens is hereby REVERSED.

The Cobb County Board of Elections and Registration is directed to notify all voters who have already received a ballot for this election that Craig Owens is a candidate for election. Further, the Cobb County Board of Elections and Registration is directed to remove any and all public notice on the Board's website that is inconsistent with this Order or any notice of the Board's previous disqualification of Craig Owens. Finally, all ballots from this date forward shall state that Craig Owens is a candidate for Sheriff of Cobb County.

Accordingly, Petitioner Craig Owens shall be placed on the ballot as a candidate for Sheriff of Cobb County in the Democratic primary election.
