**RESOLUTION APPROVING  
SUMMARY LANGUAGE  
FOR PUBLICATION OF  
ORDINANCE NO. 2024-4**

**WHEREAS**, on November 12, 2024, the City of Wahkon (the “City”) adopted Ordinance No. 2024-4, entitled AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII (TRAFFIC CODE) CHAPTER 71 (PARKING REGULATIONS) SECTION 71.03 (OTHER PARKING RESTRICTIONS) FOR THE CITY OF WAHKON, MINNESOTA (the “Ordinance”); and

**WHEREAS**, it is not practical to publish the entire text of the Ordinance in the City’s official newspaper; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized to publish only a title and summary of the ordinances it adopts pursuant to Minn. Stat. 412.191, subd. 4; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby finds and determines the following title and summary of the Ordinance is sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Wahkon hereby approves the following title and summary language for publication in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

On November 12, 2024, the City of Wahkon (the “City”) adopted Ordinance No. 2024-4, as titled above. The ordinance amends section 71.03 of the Wahkon City Code by prohibiting parking on public streets in the city between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. The prohibition is intended to facilitate snow removal, and therefore is only in effect each year between November 1 and April 1. A copy of the full ordinance is available at City Hall, on the City’s website, and can be obtained by contacting the City Clerk-Treasurer.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to:

- (1) Publish the above summary of the Ordinance once in the City’s official newspaper;
- (2) Maintain a copy of the full Ordinance at City Hall;
- (3) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Mille Lacs County Law Library; and
- (4) Place the Ordinance in the City’s Ordinance Book within 20 days together with a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.
