

MIAMI-DADE PUBLIC HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF NORTH RIVER TOWERS RFP No. NRT-2021-01

Miami-Dade County, through the Department of Public Housing and Community Development (PHCD) is soliciting proposals from developers who have the experience and capacity to obtain funding, to design and construct a residential apartment complex for the properties located 395 NW 1 Street, and 25 NW North River Drive in Miami, Florida. The properties are offered in their existing "as-is" "where-is" condition, with any and all faults, and without further contribution from the County; hereinafter described as the "Project Site." This Solicitation is for the development of the Project Site, which shall include a Two-Tower Residential Complex consisting of one tower at each site.

There will be a Pre-Proposal Conference on **Wednesday, February 17, 2021 beginning at 2:00pm at 1407 N.W. 7 Street, Suite 7, Miami, FL 33125.** Attendance at the Pre-Proposal Conference is not required and is offered as a service to potential respondents.
